Opening Remarks

For the seventh time in as many years, Hunter College is proud to announce a significant increase in grant awards. As the \$16.5 million level has been surpassed, we note that the figure is more than double the amount received in 1985.

In the fiscal year that ended June 30, 1990, the Division of Sciences and Mathematics became the first academic division at Hunter ever to exceed \$5 million. Other areas of the College that achieved their best year ever in grant and contract awards were the School of Health Sciences, the Brookdale Center on Aging, and the Center for Puerto Rican Studies.

Fiscal year 1990 also marks the first time that the American Social History Project and the Center for the Study of Family Policy are being shown as separate administrative regions.

As we enter another year of extremely tight State tax-levy funding, we draw encouragement from the members of the faculty and staff who have clearly demonstrated their commitment to their disciplines and their students by taking the time to apply for funding for the projects listed in this report.

In virtually each year that I have served as Director of Research Administration at Hunter College, I have been faced with a pleasant problem -- what superlatives may I use that I have not used previously. The faculty and staff of Hunter College have created this "problem" by showing a rise in grants for the twelfth time in the last thirteen years.

One of the past year's most interesting statistics is that we scored our highest dollar volume ever in each of the six areas that provide grant and contract support -- the Federal, State, and City agencies that comprise the public sector, and corporations, foundations, and non-profit organizations that form the private sector.

Other highlights of this report are:

- Grant and contract dollars dedicated to research, training, program development, and conference and publication support set new marks.
- There were 311 awards during the year ending June 30, 1990, also a new record.
- Adding the \$16,514,596 of grants from the public and private sectors to the funds awarded in the PSC-CUNY Research Award Program, other internal Hunter and CUNY grant programs, and fellowships and other grants made directly to individual faculty and staff members and several of their students, the total availability of funds reached \$17.5 million. This is shown in the final section of the report.

This report is meant to recognize the achievements of those faculty, staff and students who competed for funding. Our congratulations to all who give this report its luster.



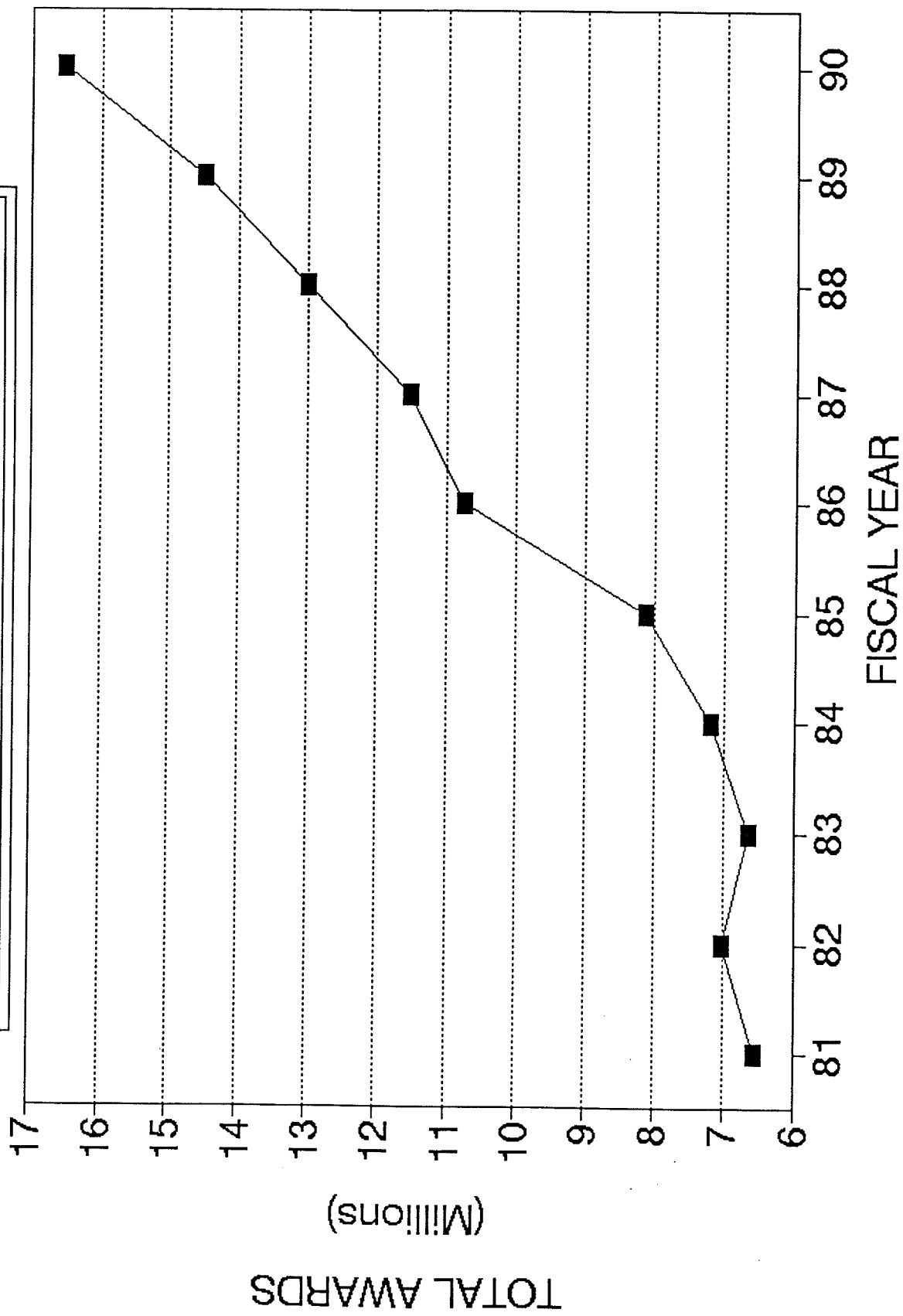
Section I-A: OVERVIEW OF EXTERNAL FUNDING

This section contains statistical information on grants and contracts from external sources, i.e., agencies of Federal, State, and City governments, foundations corporations, and non-profit organizations. For the sake of making comparisons, figures are given for the ten-year period back to 1981.

For statistical purposes, although the Minority Biomedical Research Support and Biomedical Research Support grants are awarded for "sub-projects" to faculty members from four departments in two academic regions (Divisions of Sciences and Mathematics and Social Sciences), the grants are included only once in each division's project count.

DOLLAR VOLUME

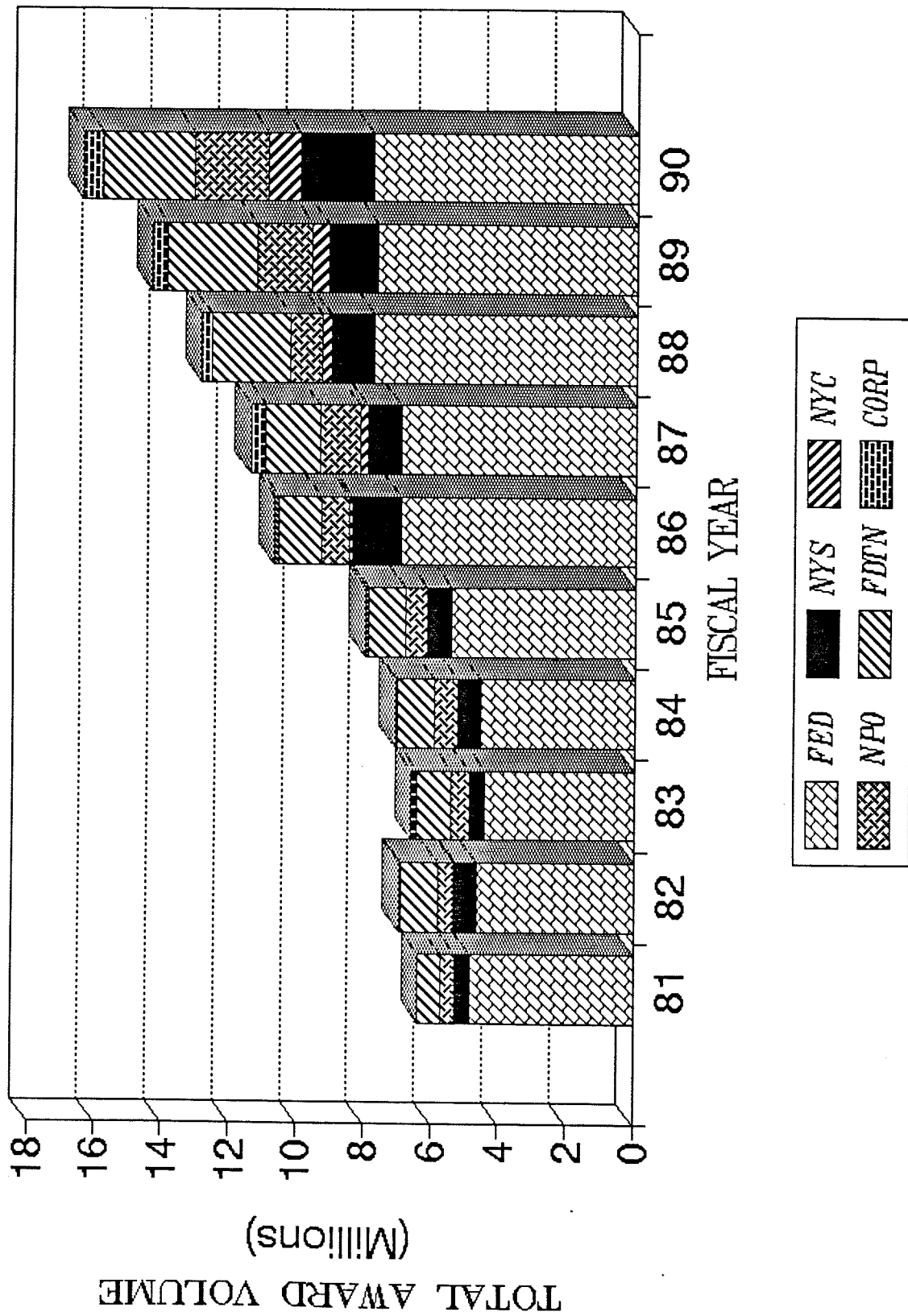

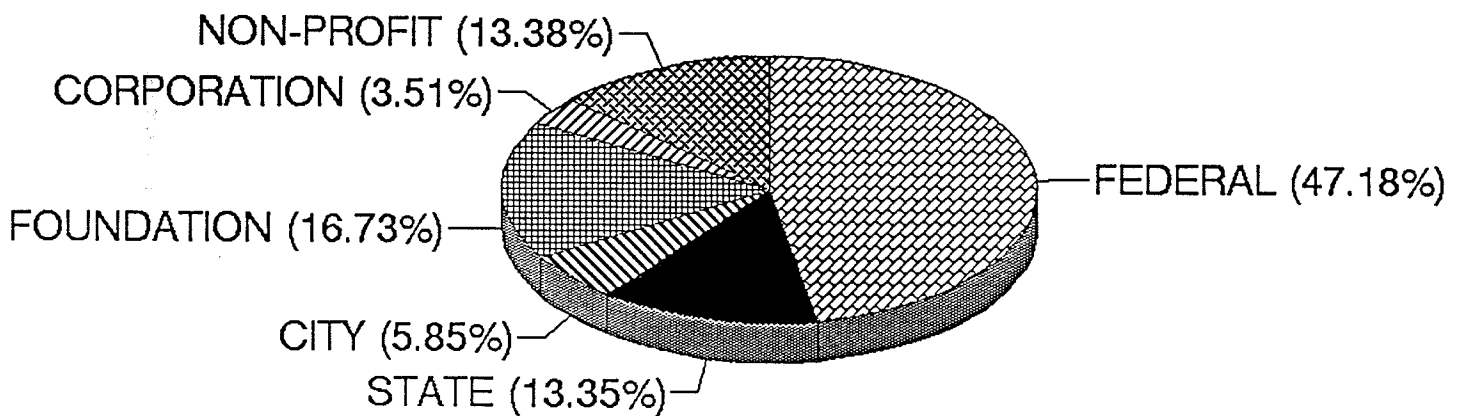

AWARDS RECEIVED IN 1990: COMPARISON OF SOURCES

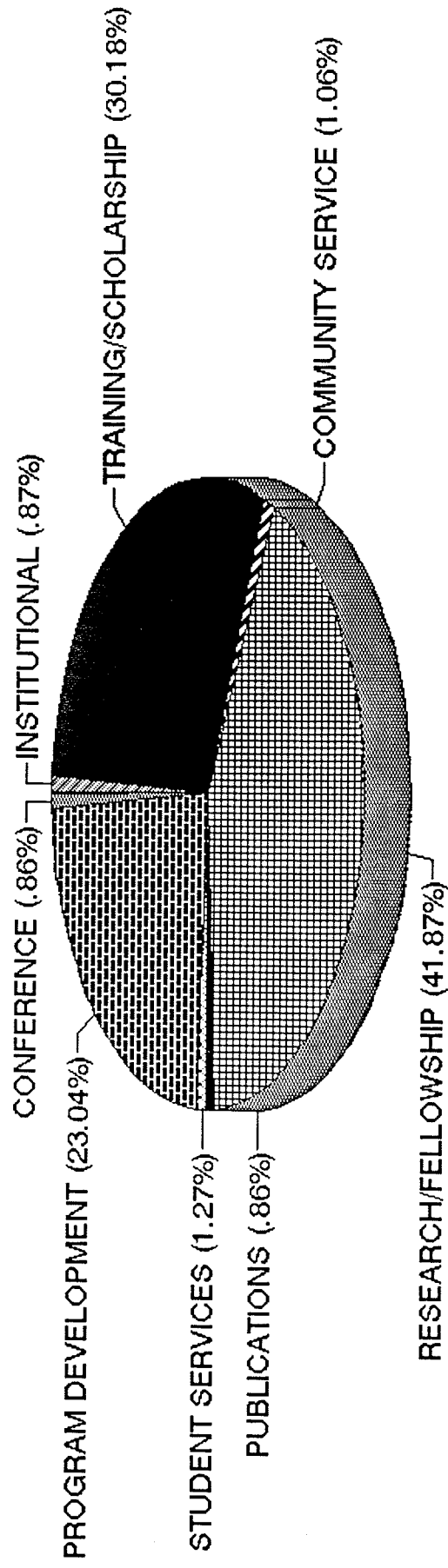

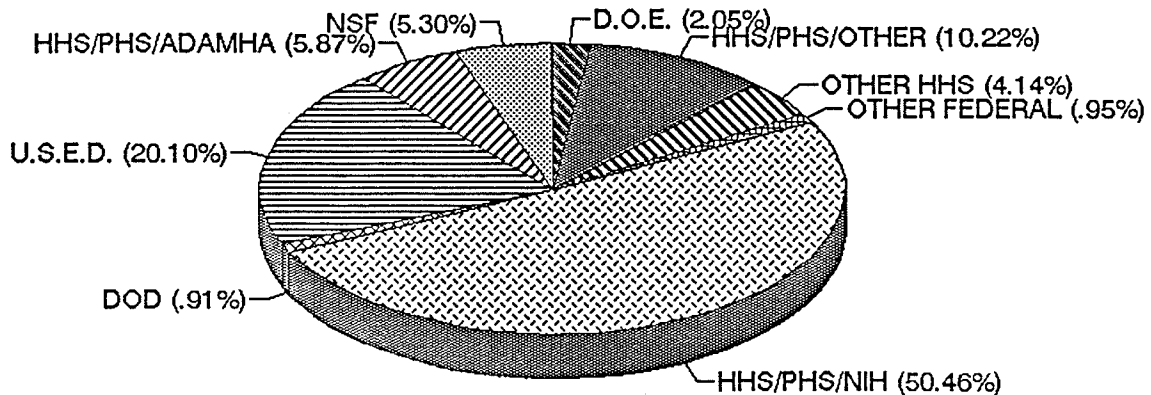

Section I-B: INDIVIDUAL PROJECT LISTING

This section's 57 pages list the individual projects that comprised the year's record of awards sponsored by external sources. Also included are grants made directly to individuals (e.g., fellowships), but these figures are not included in the previous section's overall statistics on institutionally administered awards. In several cases, Hunter faculty have co-principal investigators at other institutions. When fiscal responsibility for an award lies with a colleagues's institution, CUNY collaborations are counted in the dollar total shown, and non-CUNY administered awards are listed but not counted.

Awards are arranged alphabetically by academic and administrative regions. Within that framework, awards are organized first by department and then by faculty member. Entries include the name of the funding agency, and when applicable, the agency identification number and remarks. Among other data shown are the Research Foundation account number and the award period. "Type" indicates whether the award is new, a continuation (non-competitive but contingent on sufficient progress having been demonstrated to warrant continued funding), a renewal (after competitive review of an ongoing project), or a supplement (additional funding to complete or only slightly extend the scope of the original project). When applicable, the "status" gives the length of the project in years and whether the agency has indicated its intention to continue funding on a non-competitive basis beyond the current period.
